Separate sealed BIDS for construction of roadway and railroad crossing improvements in Fruitland Idaho, as set forth in the Contract Documents for the **STC-38358, West 1st St, INPR RRX 819917L**, Project will be received by City of Fruitland at the City Hall, Office of the City Clerk, 200 S. Whitley Drive, Fruitland, Idaho 83619, until **2:00 p.m.** local time on **June 17th 2026** and then publicly opened and read aloud at said City Hall.

This project is funded in part through Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) and **Buy America and Davis Bacon Wages are in effect for this project. All project requirements are based on ITD Standards and the construction will be administered by the City of Fruitland.** The Contractor shall coordinate all work with the Idaho Northern and Pacific Railroad (INPR), and City Public Works Director. The work to be performed by the Contractor includes the construction of approximately 300 feet of roadway including curb gutter and sidewalk, culvert and irrigation replacements for the Farmers Co-Op Canal, thermoplastic pavement markings, asphalt paving, excavation, base course and other miscellaneous items of work including railroad crossing improvements to be completed by INPR. All parts or work not specifically mentioned which are necessary in order to provide a complete installation shall be included in the bid and shall conform to all City of Fruitland requirements.

All bids must be signed and accompanied by evidence of authority to sign.

Bids must be accompanied by Bid Security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, cashiers check or cash in the amount of 5% of the amount of the bid proposal. Said bid security shall be forfeited to the City of Fruitland as liquidated damages should the successful bidder fail to enter into contract in accordance with their proposal as specified in the Instructions to Bidders.
