8. WATER/SEWER FEES:

Sewer:

Sewer	\$37.80 per ERU, per month. The minimum charge for industrial, commercial, and institutional users shall be based on the ERU multiplier as set forth in the <i>ERU Multiplier for Water Service Line Size</i> chart. Exceptions to the ERU multiplier calculation shall apply to multifamily dwellings, apartment complexes, manufactured home parks, and multiple business complexes, which may be billed based on actual unit count or other approved methodologies as provided in City Code 8-1-1.
Unoccupied Structures	\$20.00 per month for those unoccupied structures qualifying pursuant to section 8-2-3 of City Code. Properties receiving only a sewer service and no water service do not qualify.

Water:

Water	\$46.50 minimum for ¾ inch service with 6,000 gallons included per ERU, plus \$5.50 per 1,000 gallons used over 6,000 gallons, per month. The minimum monthly charge for industrial, commercial, and institutional users shall be determined by using the ERU Multiplier as set forth in the <i>ERU Multiplier for Water Service Line Size chart</i> . Exceptions to the ERU multiplier calculation shall apply to multifamily dwellings, apartment complexes, manufactured home parks, and multiple business complexes, which may be billed based on actual unit count or other approved methodologies as provided in City Code 8-1-1.
Unoccupied Structures	\$27.00 per month for those unoccupied structures qualifying pursuant to section 8-2-3 of City Code.

Water/Sewer Fines & Forfeits:

Delinquency Fee	\$5.00. A delinquency fee of five dollars (\$5.00) will be assessed if payment is not received by the 25 th day of the month in which payment is due.
On/Off Fee (Non- Pay)	\$50.00. A Fifty dollar turn on charge will be assessed as a condition of receiving water service again once services have been terminated due to lack of payment.
Meter Tamper Lockout Fee	A \$75.00 lockout fee shall be charged each time the City locks out a water meter due to tampering, whether current or past. If an account or property has a history of tampering, the meter will be locked out each time service is discontinued, including for non-payment or vacancy, until cleared by the City. Meters at vacant properties may also be locked out as a preventative measure if tampering is deemed likely.
Construction or Bulk Re-Billing	\$10.00. Construction or bulk fees are due and payable by the end of the month they are billed. Late payment may result in a delinquency charge of ten dollars (\$10.00) per month.

- The billing cycle shall run from the 21st of each month through the 20th of the following month for exceedances and testing costs.
